#### Rules & Entry Information

**Rulebook:** This show will follow the 2024-2026 AMA rule book for all approved classes. 2024 World Ranch Horse Assoc. rules will be followed for All Breed Ranch Classes. Judge's opinion is final.

AMA Fees are included in class entry fees. READ YOUR RULEBOOK! If you don't know something, please ask show management prior to your class.

**Entry dates:** Western States Mule & Donkey and All Breed Spectacular wishes to provide top quality prizes and affordable entry fees. We are offering per class fees as well as flat fees. Early Entry fees are due no later than June 1, 2024. After June 1, 2024 entries will be charged a \$20.00/per equine late fee.

**Cross Entries:** Horses, mules and donkeys and riders may enter as many All-Breed classes as they desire, as long as they comply with the class specifications. W/J exhibitors may enter 3 gaited classes. All Breed Open classes are open to riders/equines of all ages.

**Returned Checks:** Any person writing a check on an account with insufficient funds will be charged a returned check fee of \$50.00.

**Refunds:** Entry refunds may be granted prior to June 1<sup>t</sup>, 2024 providing a written veterinarian or physician certificate (On physician letterhead) is received with refund request. If proper documentation is provided, a refund may be granted on entries, less a \$45.00 office fee. All refund requests, and necessary documentation must be submitted prior to June 1<sup>t</sup>, 2024. There will be no refunds granted after June 1<sup>t</sup>, 2024. Refunds may be held up to 30 days after the completion of the show at show management discretion. No refunds on stalls will be granted. No exceptions. No refunds for No Shows will be granted. 4% credit card fees are nonrefundable.

**Combined Classes**: Show management reserves the right to combine and/or cancel classes, if there are fewer than 3 entries in a given class. Anyone who has entered a cancelled class will be refunded their entry fee.

**UNCLAIMED AWARDS**: Unclaimed awards will not be mailed/shipped after the show. Please make arrangements to have your awards picked up prior to the conclusion of the show.

**Ties**: In the event of a tie for High Point Division Awards, ties will be broken by, A. The person showing in the least number of classes, B. If both exhibitors showed in an equal number of classes, the winner will be determined by the person winning the most first places, then seconds, etc.

**Protests:** All protests must be made in writing by the end of the show, and a protest fee of \$100.00 must accompany the protest. If the protest is found to be valid, the \$100.00 fee will be refunded. Protest information in AMA Rulebook.

**Entry Forms:** All entries must be submitted on the forms provided by WSMDS. All contestants must check out at the show office or leave an open check for completion of entries.

**Gate Calls:** A thirty (30) second gate call will be enforced. Please make every effort to be at the gate when your class is called. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be ready at the gate when their class enters the arena. Contestants needing extra time for tack changes, etc. must notify show personnel prior to gate call. The gate will be closed after 30 seconds. Late arrivals will not be permitted to enter the class.

**Youth Division:** Rider must be at least 6 years old and have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday as of January 2024.

**Novice:** Rider or Handler (Novice) not to have won 3 first place placings prior to this show. These classes are for beginners, but the equine can be experienced.

**Jackpot:** Fees for Jackpots will be \$25 per class, in addition to the class fee. If a jackpot is chosen as part of the flat fee, \$25.00 will be added to the amount due.

#### **Class Descriptions:**

Patterns will be available prior to the start of the show.

Mulemanship, Donkeymanship and Hunt Seat Equitation will include a pattern and rail work will be optional at the judge's discretion. Western and English Equitation will be rail work only.

Trail classes on Friday will be Arena Trail. Trail classes on Saturday will be Rustic Ranch Trail. No extreme obstacles will be used in either of the courses. Trail practice will be available prior to the start of the show. Patterns will be made available prior to the show online.

Open Country Pleasure: Riders will ride at the walk, and their favorite gait. Loping is permissible but not required. Open to Mules and Donkeys.

Open Discipline Rail shall be judged on the rail, riders will be asked by the judges to change gaits, extend gaits, execute turns, stops, backing, side passing. The class is not limited to the above maneuvers. Maneuvers requested will be at the judge's discretion.

Ranch Rail Pleasure is a rail class. WRHA/AMA Rules

Ranch Riding is a pattern class. WRHA/AMA Rules

Ranch Reining is a Reining pattern class. WRHA/AMA Rules

Ranch Conformation – exhibitors will show at halter (rope, nylon, leather acceptable) No Silver Halters

BIG RANCH VERSATILITY CHALLENGE – ALL BREEDS. This class will include three elements, 1. Trail, 2. Ranch Pleasure, 3. Ranch Conformation, to be judged 40%/40%/20%

RED or PURPLE HAT Pleasure Driving – Open to all equines. Drivers over 50 years wear RED hats and drivers under 50 wear PURPLE hats. Special Award to the winner of this class.
